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From the Desk of Campus Minister

For forty-four years the Sunrise-Sunsets have swiftly flown on the campuses of five educational institutions. Ordained as a Priest on 12th April 1980, I was appointed Vice-Principal of St. Blaise High School, Amboli, Andheri and within a year I was promoted to be the Principal of Sacred Heart High School, Worli. Soon, I was transferred to Thomas Baptista High School and Junior College, simultaneously teaching in St. Gonsalo Garcia College, since its inception in 1984. After a few years, I was loaned to St. Joseph's College of Arts and Commerce, Uttar Vasai, as Principal. But the maximum of my career years have been on the campus of St. Gonsalo Garcia College as a lecturer, Vice-Principal, Principal and Campus Minister. And now with a heavy heart I say 'good bye' to each of the Garcian community of staff and students as I am transferred to my native Church, Holy Spirit Church, Nandakhal, Virar West.

Working on the campus of St. Gonsalo Garcia College, as a Campus Minister for the last ten years, after I retired as the college principal, has been joy. I must say that I have enjoyed every day of my life in the company of staff and students. When I retired on 30th November 2013, I decided to concentrate on Priestly Ministry, especially of visiting the sick, the bed-ridden and hospitalized, and praying over them. The Archbishop His Grace Dr. Felix Machado conceded to my desire and appointed me as hospital minister. I started visiting various hospitals regularly, especially Cardinal Gracious Hospital. I would enter the ICU ward and pray over every patient. I also used to celebrate weekly Mass in the hospital, which was attended by Sisters and the hospital staff. I engaged the ministry and the hospitals appreciated my visits.

But after two years I was asked by the Archbishop to go back to St. Gonsalo Garcia College as 'Campus Minister', ministering to the spiritual needs of the staff and students and guiding them in times of need. As I had a good friendly cordial rapport with the staff, I willingly accepted the appointment. I was approached by the Time-table committee and asked whether I would be willing to engage some lectures of Foundation



Course at the First-Year level. I was too thrilled to accept the offer as I would be in touch with the students. During my tenure as Principal, the campus was joyfully vibrant with curricular and co-curricular activities throughout the year. Best Marathi 'Nataks' were staged for the staff and students. Countrywide Industrial tours were organized, which attracted quality students to the institution. Similar atmosphere returned to the campus when Dr. Somnath Vibhute took over the Principalship of the college. The campus came alive. With the organization of Cultural Programmes and various competitions and sports events the campus once again witnessed the joy of acting, dancing, singing and sporting. I enjoyed every moment of my presence on the campus, teaching Foundation Course, conducting morning Prayers with the choir and the Principal, guiding and counselling students, empathetic cordial interactions with the staff, attending various workshops, seminars and events and heartily enjoying all joyful cultural events. I gratefully appreciate the genuine respect and honour I received from the Principal, the Vice-Principal, the teaching and the non-teaching staff and the loving kindness from the students.

We are all travellers journeying together hand in hand on our way to our final destination. We are made in the image and likeness of God, endowed with His holiness and his intelligence. But we are all imperfect. Hence, we need each other in the times of sickness and health and in Sun and shower. Jesus has said, "I have come that you may have life in abundance." वाढती बेरोजगारी

बेरोजगारी हे मोठे आर्थिक आणि सामाजिक आव्हान आहे, जे देशातील नव्वे जगभरातील व्यक्ती आणि समाजाला प्रभावित करते. जेव्हा काम करण्यास इच्छुक आणि सक्षम व्यक्तीला रोजगार मिळू शकत नाही तेव्हा त्याला बेरोजगार असे म्हणतात. बेरोजगारी व्यक्तीला गरिबी व दारिद्र्यात नेते आणि या समस्यांमुळे व्यक्तीच्या मूलभूत आवश्यकता पूर्ण करणे कठीण होते. आज भारतात बेरोजगारीच्या समस्येला कंटाळून अनेक तरुण आत्महत्या करीत आहेत.

आज ज्या पद्धतीने देशात बेरोजगार तरुण वाढत आहेत त्यामागे अनेक कारणे आहेत, यातील एक सर्वात मोठे कारण म्हणजे आपली लोकसंख्या. जसजशी देशातील लोकसंख्या वाढत आहे तसतशी बेरोजगारीमुळे तरुणाई हवालदिल होत आहे.

देशातील वाढत्या बेरोजगारीमागील दुसरे कारण आपली शिक्षण पद्धत आहे. आज भारतात अनेक तरुण इंजिनियर बेरोजगार आहेत. आपल्या देशात प्रात्यक्षिक अभ्यासक्रमाऐवजी फक्त पुस्तकी ज्ञान दिले जाते. यामुळे ज्याला इंग्लिश मध्ये Practical Knowledge असं बोलतात त्यात विद्यार्थी कमी पडतात. आजकाल छोट्या सरकारी नोकरीसाठी अनेक विद्यार्थी मंडळी अर्ज करताना दिसतात. पण असं का? कारण हाताला रोजगार नाही आणि त्यात नाही म्हटलं तरी पैशाची चण चण!

मागच्या तीन वर्षात कोविडमुळे अनेक तरुणांनी नोकऱ्या गमावल्या. याचा परिणाम म्हणून २०२० मध्ये तब्बल ३५४८ बेरोजगारांनी हतबलतेतून आत्महत्याही केली. प्रत्येक देशात बेरोजगारीच्या नियोजनासाठी एक यंत्रणा असते आणि लोकसंख्या वाढ ज्याप्रमाणे होते त्याचप्रमाणे रोजगार निर्मिती व्हावी असा एक ठोकताळा असतो. पण भारतात हे नियोजन पूर्वीपासूनच नीट झाले नसल्याचे अर्थतज्ज्ञ सांगतात. कोरोना काळात सरकारने मनरेगाची कामे वाढवून ग्रामीण रोजगार देण्यासाठी प्रयत्न केले. पण सरकारी नोकऱ्यांचे प्रमाण वाढवण्याची गरज होती ते झाले नाही. शिवाय या भरती परीक्षांमध्ये झालेल्या गोंधळामुळे तरुणांमध्ये उद्रेक बघायला मिळाला.

बेरोजगारीला उपाय म्हणून 'स्किल इंडिया मिशन' अंतर्गत तरुणांना ट्रेनिंग आणि रोजगार उपलब्ध करून देण्यासाठी १५ जुलै २०१५ मध्ये केंद्र सरकारने स्किल इंडिया मिशनची सुरुवात केली होती. ही प्रधानमंत्री कौशल्य विकास योजना आणि उद्योग मंत्रालयाची प्रमुख योजना आहे. या योजनेअंतर्गत तरुणांना उद्योग संबंधित कौशल्य प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते. जेणेकरून ते स्वतःचा रोजगार सुरू करू शकतील. या योजनेअंतर्गत दहावी-बारावीमध्ये ज्यांनी शाळा सोडून दिली आहे किंवा कमी शिक्षित तरुणांना प्रशिक्षण दिले जाते. स्किल इंडिया मिशन अंतर्गत युवकांना फी देण्याची गरज नाही. उमेदवार तीन, सहा किंवा एका वर्षांच्या कोर्ससाठी नोंदणी करून कोर्स संपल्यावर प्रमाणपत्र मिळवू शकतात.

दिव्याच्या मोहापाई
किती पणत्या विझवणार ?
जन्मलीच नाही जिजाऊ
तर शिवबा कसा घडणार ?

शिवाजी महाराज जन्माला येतील
पण जिजाऊंना तुम्ही पोटातल्या पोटात मारता
कुठे चाललेत तुमचे विचार
मुलगा आणि मुलगी असा भेदभाव का तुम्ही करता ?

प्रत्येकांना असे वाटते की, शिवाजी महाराजांसारखा मुलगा आपल्या घराण्यात जन्मावा, पण शिवाजी महाराजांना घडविण्यात राजमाता जिजाऊ या माऊलीचा सर्वात मोठा हात होता. जर जिजाऊ सारख्या स्त्रीला जन्म देणारच नाही तर शिवबा कसा घडणार ? प्रत्येकाने जर आपल्या मोहापायी शिवाजी महाराज जन्माला यावे असा विचार केला तर राजमाता जिजाऊसारखी स्त्री गमावून बसू ? फार पूर्वीपासून आपला देश हा पुरुषप्रधान असल्याचे बिंबविले गेलेले आहे. आपली भारतीय संस्कृती मूलतः पुरुषप्रधान संस्कृती म्हणून ओळखली जाते. आपल्या देशात मुलगा हा वंशाचा दिवा आणि मुलगी हे परक्याचे धन आहे असे वाटते. ही वर्षानुवर्षापासूनची समजूत आहे.

भारतामध्ये स्त्रियांची घटणारी लोकसंख्या ही चिंतेची बाब झाली आहे. स्त्री भ्रूण हत्येमुळे लिंग - गुणोत्तर वाढत आहे.

देशातील बऱ्याच लोकांना मुलगा हा वंशाचा दिवा आपल्या म्हातारपणाची काठी असे वाटते. परंतु मुलीला मात्र ओझे मानले जाते. तिच्या शिक्षणाचा खर्च लग्नाच्यावेळी हुंड्याचा खर्च या गोष्टीमुळे मुलींना शिक्षण दिले जात नाही. तिचा आपल्याला काही फायदा नाही, शिक्षण घेऊन ती दुसऱ्याची भरभराट करणार यामुळे 'तिला' निरक्षर ठेवले जाते. लोकांना हे समजणे गरजेचे आहे की जर आपण मुलीला जन्माला येऊ दिले नाही तर आपल्याला माता, मुलगी, बहीण, मैत्रीण, पत्नी कशी काय मिळेल ? म्हणून आपल्याला स्त्री भ्रूणहत्येच्या बाबतीत अनेक ठिकाणी घटना घडताना दिसतात. स्त्रियांवर होणारे अत्याचार, स्त्रियांचा होणारा लैंगिक छळ, वाढती गुन्हेगारी आपल्याला दिसून येते. परंतु या विकृत समाजाला आई हवी, पत्नी हवी, बहीण हवी पण मुलगी मात्र नको...! मुलगी जन्माला आलीच नाही, तर ही सर्व नाती मिळणार कशी ? त्यामुळे आता 'लेक चाचवा' असे म्हणण्याची वेळ आली आहे. आज एकही क्षेत्र असे नाही की ज्या ठिकाणी स्त्रिया कार्यरत नाहीत. स्त्रियांनी अवकाशयानातून जाणे, त्याच्या निर्मितीत सहभागी असणे, वैमानिक, वैज्ञानिक, रेल्वे चालक, क्रीडा राजकारण, डॉक्टर, पोलीस, वकील, इंजिनियरींग या क्षेत्रात महत्त्वाची कामगिरी बजावली आहे.

आजच्या काळात विज्ञानाने बरीच प्रगती केली व याच प्रगत विज्ञानाचा फायदा चुकीच्या पद्धतीने काही लोक गर्भलिंग चाचणी म्हणजेच आईच्या पोटी नक्की कोणता गर्भ वाढतोय, म्हणजेच तो गर्भ कोणता आहे ती चाचणी करण्याकडे कल वाढत आहे. बऱ्याच समाजात तर स्त्रीलिंग असले की तिला गर्भातच मारून टाकले



जाते. आर्थिक आणि सामाजिक परिस्थिती, भारतातील स्त्री-पुरुष असमानता, हुंडा पद्धती, पुरुषप्रधान संस्कृती, इत्यादी आपल्याला स्त्री भ्रूणहत्येची कारणे दिसून येतात. म्हणून भारत सरकारने ही स्त्री भ्रूणहत्या रोखण्यासाठी २००४ साली PCPNDT या कायद्याची अंमलबजावणी करून 'स्त्रीभ्रूण हत्या' हा गुन्हा घोषित केला.

जर राणी लक्ष्मीबाईंना त्यांच्या आई-वडीलांनी जन्म दिला नसता तर आपल्याला झाशीची राणी मिळाली असती का? कल्पना चावला यांच्यासारखा भारतातील पहिल्या महिला अंतराळवीर, सावित्रीबाई फुले यांच्यासारख्या स्त्री शिक्षणाच्या ज्योति, सिंधुताई सपकाळसारखी अनाथांची माय, प्रतिभाताई पाटील यांच्यासारखी राष्ट्रपती, पी.टी. उषाप्रमाणे धावपटू, किरण बेदीप्रमाणे IPS अधिकारी, मिताली राजप्रमाणे महिला क्रिकेटपटू तर जिजाऊ नसत्या तर छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांसारखे राजे लाभू शकले असते का? माता भिमाई नसत्या तर संविधानाचे जनक डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर यांच्यासारखे महापुरुष जन्मास आले असते का? या सर्वांच्या आई- वडीलांनी जर मुलगी परक्याचे धन आहे असे समजून जर मुलींना जन्मच दिला नसता तर ही महान माणसं कधीच जन्मास आली नसती.

बेटी बचाओ, बेटी पढ़ाओ

माँ, बहन और पत्नी ये सभी एक महिला के ही रूप हैं, हर रूप में वो सम्माननीय है, प्रेम और आदर के योग्य है। संसार में जीवन इनकी वजह से संभव है।

आज भी शायद बहुत से लोग इस बात को समझ नहीं पाए हैं इसलिए वे बेटी और बेटे में भेदभाव करते हैं। बेटियों को हीन समझते हैं और उन्हें उनके अधिकारों से वंचित रखते हैं। किसी कवि ने ठीक ही कहा है कि - मेहनत करते हैं बेटे, पर अब्बल आती हैं बेटियाँ,

रुलाते हैं जब खूब बेटे, तब हंसाती हैं बेटियाँ

नाम करें न करे बेटे, पर नाम कमाती हैं बेटियाँ.....

हमारे पुरुष प्रधान भारत देश में बालिकाओं की दशा अच्छी नहीं है। कई लोग घर में बेटी का जन्म होना अच्छा नहीं मानते और कई बार तो उन्हें जन्म लेने से पहले ही उनकी हत्या कर दी जाती है। ऐसे लोगों का मानना है कि बेटियाँ बोझ होती हैं और बेटे कमाई का साधन।

ये सिर्फ दकियानूसी सोच ही है, वरना आज के इस युग में महिलाएं किसी भी क्षेत्र में पुरुषों से कम नहीं हैं। कल्पना चावला, किरण बेदी, किरण मजुमदार, पी टी उषा, सानिया मिर्जा, साइना नेहवाल ने भारत में नहीं बल्कि विदेशों में भी प्रसिद्धी प्राप्त की है।

प्रियंका चोपड़ा, ऐश्वर्या राय, लारा दत्ता, सुष्मिता सेन ने दुनिया में भारतीय सुंदरता और समझदारी का झंडा लहराया। सरकारी और गैर सरकारी संस्थानों में भी महिलाओं के प्रतिशत में बहुत अधिक बढ़ोतरी हुई है।

आज महिलाएं घरों में बंद एक अबला नहीं हैं बल्कि एक शक्तिशाली व्यक्ति की मालकिन बन गई हैं। खेल, चिकित्सा, व्यापार, राजनीति, फिल्म, चकालत जैसे सारे क्षेत्रों में महिलाओं की शक्ति साफ नजर आती है।

फिर भी कुछ तुच्छ मानसिकता के लोग बेटियों को उचित शिक्षा नहीं देते हैं और उन्हें घर के काम काज में लगा देते हैं, जिसकी वजह से बालिकाओं का भविष्य अंधरे में है।

बालिकाओं को किसी पारिवारिक निर्णय या फैसले पर अपनी बात कहने का भी हक नहीं मिलता है। उनको हर वस्तु से वंचित रखा जाता है। कुछ घरों में तो बालिकाओं के साथ जैसे किसी वस्तु की तरह बर्ताव किया जाता है और उन्हें स्नेह, ममता और प्यार तो सपने में भी नहीं मिलता।

देश के कई राज्यों में लिंगानुपात अत्यधिक गिर गया है और बेटियों की संख्या प्रतिदिन कम होती जा रही है। इसे देखते हुए सरकार ने एक योजना का शुभारंभ किया ताकि देश की बेटियों की स्थिति में सुधार किया जा सके। किसी ने सही कहा है-

कैसे खाओगे उनके हाथ की रोटियाँ,

जब पैदा ही नहीं होने दोगे बेटियाँ।

'बेटी बचाओ बेटी पढ़ाओ' योजना का अर्थ है कन्या शिशु को बचाइए और उन्हें शिक्षित कीजिए। हमारे देश के प्रधानमंत्री श्री नरेंद्र मोदी जी ने २२ जनवरी २०१६ को बालिका दिवस के मौके पर इस योजना की शुरुवात की।

जिससे समाज में बेटियों को उनके अधिकार मिल सकें! बेटी बचाओ अभियान का तात्पर्य केवल बेटियों को बचाना और पढ़ाना ही नहीं बल्कि सदियों से चली आ रही धार्मिक प्रथाओं एवं गलत मानसिक विचारधारा में परिवर्तन लाना भी है। महिलाओं के शिक्षित होने से वे अपने पर होने वाले उत्पीड़न का विरोध कर सकती हैं और अपने अधिकार की माँग कर सकती हैं।

इस अभियान का मुख्य उद्देश्य भारत में निरंतर घट रही महिलाओं की जनसंख्या के करने के साथ-साथ उनके हक एवं अधिकारों की पूर्ति करना भी है। भारतीय संविधान द्वारा महिलाओं को प्रदत्त अधिकार जैसे शिक्षा का अधिकार, समान सेवा का अधिकार तथा सम्मान के साथ जीने के अधिकार को सुनिश्चित करता है।

बालिकाओं की स्थिति में सुधार लाने के लिए हम और लोगों को जागरूक होना होगा और सभी को एकजुट होकर इस समस्या का समाधान करना होगा! सरकार द्वारा चलाई गई इस मुहिम का सकारात्मक प्रभाव आज हमें देखने को मिल रहा है।

एक बच्ची दुनिया में आकर सबसे पहले बेटी बनती है। वे अपने माता-पिता के लिए विपत्ति के समय में ढाल बनकर खड़ी रहती है। बालिका बन कर भाई की मदद करती है। बाद में धर्मपत्नी बनकर अपने पति और ससुराल वालों का हर अच्छी बुरी परिस्थिति में साथ निभाती हैं।

वह त्यागमूर्ति माँ के रूप में अपने बच्चों पर सब कुछ कुर्बान कर जाती है और अपने बच्चों में अच्छे संस्कारों के बीज बोती है, जिससे वे आगे चलकर अच्छे इन्सान बने। सभी को बेटे और बेटों के साथ एक समान व्यवहार करना चाहिए। आज सेवा के क्षेत्र में लड़कों से कहीं आगे बढ़ती जा रही है। सुई से लेकर जहाज निर्माण में, एक गृहिणी से लेकर राष्ट्रपति के पद तक, चिकित्सा से लेकर देश की रक्षा में भी अपना सहयोग दे रही हैं।

बेटियों को समान रूप से शिक्षा और जीवन स्तर देना चाहिए, समान अधिकार और प्यार-दुलार देना चाहिए, क्योंकि किसी भी देश के विकास के लिए बेटियाँ समान रूप से जिम्मेदार हैं।

मैं एक किसान हूँ। मुझे गर्व है की मेरा जन्म भारत में हुआ है। मुझे लोग अन्नदाता भी कहते हैं क्योंकि मैं लोगों के लिए अन्न उपजाता हूँ। मेरी जिंदगी परिश्रम और कठिनाईयों से भरी है। लेकिन फिर भी मैं दिन-रात कड़ी मेहनत करता हूँ। मेरा जीवन आर्थिक तंगी से उलझा हुआ है। लेकिन फिर भी मैं हर मौसम में हार न मानकर खेती का काम करता रहता हूँ। मैं अनाज उगाकर देश के सभी लोगों को भुखमरी से बचाता हूँ और उनकी भूख मिटाता हूँ। मैं अन्नदाता के तौर पर दिन-रात काम करता हूँ।

मैं एक गरीब परिवार में पैदा हुआ। इसलिए मैं शिक्षा हासिल नहीं कर सका और आज कृषि का काम कर रहा हूँ, खेती का काम करना मुझे अच्छा लगता है। मुझे बहुत ज्यादा मेहनत करनी पड़ती है। दिन-रात मेहनत करनी पड़ती है। हर मौसम में मुझे चाहे धूप हो या फिर चाहे ठंड हो मुझे खेती का काम करना पड़ता है। हालांकि आज के समय में मेरे जीवन में तकनीक की वजह से काफी सुविधाएँ आई हैं और हमारा जीवन स्तर काफी उँचा हुआ है। लेकिन पुराने जमाने में हमें बहुत ज्यादा मेहनत करनी पड़ती थी। बैल और हल के जरिए हमें भूमि को जोतना पड़ता था। आज बैल की जगह ट्रैक्टर ने ले ली है और जिससे हमारी जिंदगी काफी सरल हुई है। लेकिन फिर भी हम को हर मौसम में खेती के काम से फुर्सत नहीं मिलती है और हम अपने सच्चे मित्र भी हमारी भूमि और फसल को ही मानते हैं और इनसे ही हमें प्यार है। कांटो से भरपूर जीवन होने के बावजूद भी मैं आत्मसन्मान के साथ जीता हूँ। कभी किसी के सामने हाथ नहीं फैलाता। मेरा जीवन संघर्ष से भरा रहता है। लेकिन फिर भी मैं छोटी छोटी खुशियों में ही अपनी खुशी मानकर जीवन जीता हूँ और मेहनत करता रहता हूँ। कड़ी मेहनत के बाद खेत में जब लहराती हुई फसल देखता हूँ तो मुझे बड़ा सुकून मिलता है। मुझे अच्छा महसूस होता है।

मेरी दिनचर्या दूसरे लोगों की तरह सरल नहीं होती। मेरा पूरा परिवार सुबह सूरज निकलने से पहले जाग जाता है। मेरा एक छोटा-सा खेत है। दोपहर तक मैं खेत का सारा काम निपटा लेता हूँ जैसे की फसल बुआई, सिंचाई, कटाई। दोपहर के समय एक छायादार पेड़ के नीचे अपना भोजन करता हूँ और फिर थोड़ा आराम करता हूँ। शाम को थका हारा घर लौटता हूँ। रात को खाना खाकर जल्दी सो जाता हूँ। हमारा भोजन भी सादा होता है ज्यादातर रोटी और सब्जी। मुझे कोई छुट्टी नहीं मिलती। सभी प्रकार के मौसम में मुझे काम करना पड़ता है। मेरे साथ साथ मेरा परिवार भी खेतों में मेरी मदद करता है। खेत ही हमारा सर्वस्व होता है और अनाज के दाने मेहनत के मोती हैं।

बहु अपनी ताकत नहीं जानता, जिसने प्रतिकूल परिस्थितियों का सामना नहीं किया।



मेरे पहनावे में आपको सादगी नजर आएगी। उसमें कुछ तडक-भडक नहीं है। सादा-सा कुर्ताल, धोती और पाँव में टूटे फूटे जूते। हमारे पास बहुत कम कपडे होते हैं। लेकिन आज कल मेरे रहन सहन में भी छोटे-छोटे बदलाव आ रहे हैं। मुझे अपने खेतों में काम करने से ज्यादा फुरसत नहीं मिलती इसलिए मेरे बहुत कम मित्र हैं। लेकिन मेरा सच्चा मित्र मेरा हल और बैल है, जो पूरे दिन मेरे साथ रहते हैं। मेरे पास दो बैल हैं। बैल को नहलाना और खाना खिलाना मुझे काफी अच्छा लगता है। अब तो मेरे बैल की जगह ट्रैक्टर ने ले ली है। लेकिन फिर भी मैं अपने बैल को इतना ही प्यार करता हूँ जैसे पहले करता था।

मेरा जीवन प्रकृति पर निर्भर करता है। अगर बारिश अच्छी हो तो फसल अच्छी होती है लेकिन जब कुदरती आपदाएँ आती हैं तब सारी फसल खराब हो जाती है। हमारी पूरी मेहनत पर पानी फिर जाता है और मेरे पूरे परिवार की हालत खराब हो जाती है। छोटी-सी छोटी खुशियों को पूरा करने के लिए मुझे काफी मेहनत करनी पड़ती है। मैं अपने बच्चों को पाठशाला भेजता हूँ ताकि उनका भविष्य सुनहरा बना सकूँ। अब हमें सरकार की ओर से भी काफी सहायता मिलती है। सरकार अब हमारे खेतों के लिए बिजली और पानी देती है। हमें कृषि आधारित शिक्षा देती है। कृषि में भी अब तकनीक बढ़ने के कारण जिससे हमारा जीवनस्तर ऊँचा गया है। जीवन स्तर बदलने के बावजूद भी बढ़ती महंगाई के कारण आज भी मेरे परिवार को दो वक्त की रोटी भी बड़ी मुश्किल से मिलती है। बीज की किमते दिन-ब-दिन बढ़ रही हैं। जिसके कारण अच्छी गुणवत्ता के खाद्य और बीज खरीदने में पसीना छूट जाता है।

गांधीजी और लाल बहादूर शास्त्री ने हमें देश की आत्मा का मान दिया था। लेकिन समाज में हमारी गिनती गरीबों में की थी। व्यापारी लोग हमसे अनाज कम दामों में लेकर उसे बाजार में ज्यादा दामों में बेचते हैं और ढेर सारा मुनाफा कमाते हैं। हमारी जिंदगी कर्ज में डुबी हुई है। आज भी लोग हमें अनपढ़ और गवार समझते हैं। आज भी समाज में हमारी स्थिति गुलामों की तरह है। हर साल कर्ज में डुबे हमारे किसान भाई आत्महत्या करते हैं लेकिन समाजपर इन सब घटनाओं का कोई प्रभाव नहीं पड़ता।

"Is the Indian economy on track to becoming a \$5 trillion economy by 2025

Today, India is one of the fastest growing major economies and is currently ranked as the world's sixth largest economy.

According to the government's 2023 budget documents, India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) was estimated to be Rs 273.1 trillion, or \$3.3 trillion at the current exchange rate of Rs 83 per dollar.

To reach \$5 trillion, the dollar value of the GDP needs to grow by 52%, or by 8.7% per year in nominal terms if we choose a horizon of 5 years.

However, The Working Group of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry of the Government of India is trying to develop a roadmap towards achieving a 5 trillion-dollar economy by 2025.

The current structure of the economy and the emerging dynamics provide us grounds to target achieving 1 trillion-dollar from agriculture and allied activities, 1 trillion from manufacturing and 3 trillion from services.

Some major reforms undertaken by the Government to boost the Indian economy include-

- Goods and Services Tax (GST).
- Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC).
- Significant reduction in the corporate tax rate.
- The Make in India and Start-up India strategies.
- Production Linked Incentive Schemes.

But there are some issues that cannot be overlooked in this race for a 5 trillion-dollar economy-

- The adverse impact on marginalized citizens.
- The wealth disparity issue, with 1% of the population owning a significant portion of the nation's wealth.
- The inability of a large segment of the population to participate in cutting-edge sectors such as AI, data science, and fintech.
- Absence of estimates on India's per capita income at the \$5 trillion GDP mark.

Economy is defined as the process or system by which goods and services are produced, sold, and bought in a country or region. For this we consider only the GDP.

But an economy is sustainable only if there is an increase in economic production resulting in-

- Higher real wages.
- Higher employment.
- Higher spending.



- Low and stable inflation.
- Low unemployment.

Is this what we mean by a \$5 trillion economy that India aspires to be? NO.

Our GDP could reach that astounding figure. But the ECONOMY is not just the GDP. We have to reflect on the requisites of a good economy. And that is possible only when along with the increase in economic activities, care is taken to-

- Check population explosion.
- Proliferate education.
- Control money supply to control inflation.
- Ensure equitable capital formation to reduce inequality.
- Create and commensurate job opportunities.

Another aspect that cannot be overlooked is that India has bilateral trade relations with many countries and has played a pivotal and influential role in organisations like.

- The World Trade Organization.
- The International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- The Shanghai Cooperation.

Consequently, the Indian economy has to consider integration with these economies while making a calculated effort to reach the \$5 trillion mark.

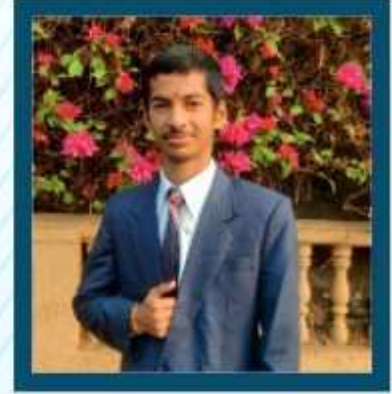

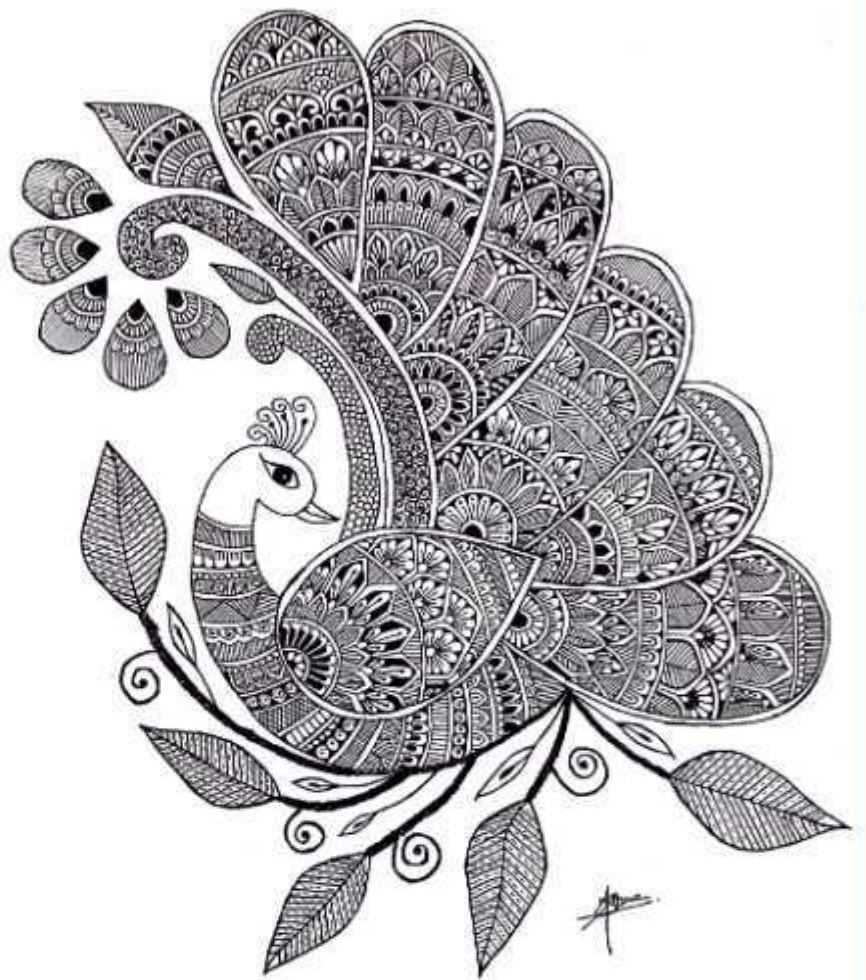

On 23rd February 2024, our T.Y.B.Sc.(IT) and S.Y.B.Sc.(IT) students, a group of 40 along with 2 faculty members, had the opportunity to visit a cutting-edge 4-tier data center 'YOTTA', located at Panvel, as part of an industrial visit. The visit aimed to provide insights into the operations, infrastructure, and technologies employed in data centers to support modern businesses & digital needs. The journey to and fro was made by road in a bus. It took around 4 hours to reach the facility. Upon arrival, we were greeted by the imposing structure of the facility, showcasing its robust construction and security measures. The HR personnel at Yotta escorted us after a hearty breakfast to tour the facility. The data center is classified as a 4-tier facility, indicating its high level of reliability, redundancy, and availability. Each tier represents a level of infrastructure resilience, with Tier 4 being the highest.

Security is paramount within the data center, with biometric access controls, surveillance and 24/7 security personnel ensuring the protection of sensitive information and equipment. We learned about the stringent protocols in place to prevent unauthorized access and mitigate potential security threats.

Maintaining optimal operating conditions is critical in data center to ensure the performance and longevity of hardware. The facility featured advanced cooling systems, including precision air conditioning and hot aisle/cold aisle containment, to regulate temperature and humidity levels efficiently. Additionally, environmental controls such as world class fire suppression systems were in place to safeguard against unforeseen emergencies.



The power supply and networking infrastructure of the data center was a focal point of the tour, showcasing high-speed network connections, and scalable architecture to accommodate growing demands for data transmission. We learned about the importance of latency reduction and network optimization in supporting the seamless operation of digital services. The visit provided the students valuable insights into the intricate workings of modern data infrastructure. They gained a deeper appreciation for the complexities involved in maintaining high levels of reliability, security, and performance in the digital age. Overall, the industrial visit was an enlightening and informative experience, offering a glimpse into the future of data management and technology. Later, they were also guided by Dr. Nikita Patel, psychiatrist and counsellor at Tripta Foundation. She explained the importance of sharing what one feels, especially if one feels an uncontrollable urge to consume any addictive substance over and over again. She also assured that early help can help in the rapid recovery of any person with addiction. "Not only the person who goes through the addiction recovery phase but also their family members need counselling in such matters," she said. The students learnt what 'hearing' the other person means, what 'empathy' is, and how to practice such behaviour to help others. They left the NGO at 10:30 a.m. with important lessons for life.

Last but not least, no college trip is complete without some fun and enjoyment. So, to tick that off as part of their 'college trip' bucket list, the students went to D' Atlantic Aqua Park Resort. They had to dive into truckloads of memories to last forever and swim their stress out before they concluded the day and set off for college at 5:00 p.m.

ENROLLMENT OF FIRST-YEAR CADETS:

Hybrid Mode

The ten-day workshop on "Research Methodology and Data Analysis" conducted by the IQAC of St. Gonsalo Garcia College of Arts and Commerce, Vasai was a success as around 97 participants registered for it. The workshop started on 15th February and the valedictory programme was conducted on the tenth day 24th February 2024. For the inauguration of the Workshop **chief guest Prof. Dr. Mahadev Deshmukh, Dean, Humanities and Social Sciences, Shivaji University,** addressed the participants in online mode. He discussed the importance of inculcating ethical research practices and introduced the participants to the basics of research. The principal of St. Gonsalo Garcia College of Arts and Commerce, Vasai, the IQAC Coordinator and Vice Principal of St. Gonsalo Garcia College, Prof. Saritha Kurian along with the participants attended the inaugural session.

After the inaugural session, **Principal Dr. Somnath Vibhute** conducted the **first session** of the first day. He pointed out the importance of "**Research Design**" in the process of research of any volume. Without research design, it becomes difficult to keep the research process on the right track. The **evening session** was conducted by **Dr. Vikki Gayakavad**. His topic was "Foundations of Research Methodology: The Difference between Philosophy, Theory and Criticism". Philosophical concepts are the foundations of research. Theoretical frameworks and a researcher's statements in terms of criticism are inevitable parts of the research process. But at the same time, any researcher needs to acknowledge the differences among these three elements as formulating research problems and looking for the methods to solve those problems is an outcome of the right use of philosophical concepts and theoretical frameworks.

On the **second day, the first session** was conducted by **Prof. Sangeeta Pawar**. She focused on Research Design. While discussing the research process she highlighted the significance of Data Analysis. Various methods of data analysis were discussed as the participants were from various fields like Economics, English Literature and



from his session was the timeline a researcher has to follow while reviewing literature related to the research topic.

On the **third day**, the **first session** was conducted by **Dr. Mandar Bhanushe**. His topic was **"R and Data Analysis"**. He discussed the applications and functionalities of the R tool software for data analysis, an overview of R tool software, emphasizing its significance in modern scientific research and technological advancements. He elucidated the versatility of R, showcasing its capabilities in data visualization, statistical analysis, and predictive modelling across various domains. The second session was conducted by Dr. Rajendra Kumbhar on the topic **"Identification of Research Problem"**. The session aimed to equip attendees with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively identify and formulate research problems in various disciplines. Dr. Kumbhar discussed the role of stakeholders and real-world challenges in shaping research problems. He emphasized the importance of engaging with practitioners, policymakers, and other relevant stakeholders to identify research problems that address practical issues and have meaningful implications for society.

On the **fourth day**, **Mr. Chinmay Gavankar**, Director-Solution Specialist @ Microsoft discussed the important role played by **Artificial Intelligence in Education and Research**. He emphasised the fact that Artificial Intelligence has become a non-negligible part of human life and as students and teachers in the various fields of research we need to diligently use AI in research. However, he also stated that human intelligence can never be replaced by any kind of AI as the kind of creativity the human brain has is irreplaceable. Both the sessions on the fourth day were conducted by Mr. Chinmay Gavankar.

On the **fifth day**, the **first session** was conducted by **Prof. Dr. Arvind Luhar**. His topic was **"Importance of Identification of Research Gap"**. Identification of the research gap is an important aspect of research in the early stage of the research process. The research heads in the right direction if the research gap is identified early and in the right manner. Dr. Luhar shared a few tricks for identifying research gaps. The **second session** was conducted by **Dr. Shubhada Nagarkar**, who along with being an Associate Professor at the Department of Library and Information Science, at Savitribai Phule Pune University, also happens to be the Coordinator of the Centre for Publication Ethics and a Member of UGC-CARE Empowered Committee. Her topic was **"Publication Ethics"**. She focussed on the ethics to be followed while conducting research as well as publishing research papers. She gave information about predatory journals and how to avoid publishing in them.



On the sixth day, the first session was conducted by **Prof. Dr. Sucharita Sarkar** on the topic “**MLA, CMS and APA style guides, In-text and footnote citations and bibliography**”. Prof. Sarkar discussed the various style guides for references, footnotes and bibliography in detail giving examples from a variety of research writings. The **second session** was conducted by **Prof. Dr. Sachin Gadekar**. His topic was “**Writing a Research Paper**”. Prof. Gadekar discussed in detail the important aspects of the process of writing a research paper.

On the **seventh day**, the **first session** was conducted by **Dr. B. L. Chavan**. His topic was **Methods, Types, Tools and Techniques in Scientific Research “Data Collection**”. Dr. Chavan in his session discussed various methods of data collection for research. He emphasised the fact that the right methods of data collection are necessary for the accurate outcome of the data analysis. The **second session** was conducted by **Dr. Gopal Kalkoti**. His topic was “**Data Collection, Interpretation and Analysis**”. Dr. Kalkoti in his lively session conducted a few activities so that the participants understand the process of data collection and its interpretation and analysis.

The **eighth day** started with the **first session** by **Prof. Dr. Paromita Chakrabarti**. Her topic was “**Writing for Research: Perspectives on Critical Thinking and Communication**”. Prof. Paromita highlighted the importance of a lucid writing style and a few phrases that make the writing appear analytical. Formation of active sentence structures and bringing in the neutrality of the subject while writing for research were also emphasised by her. The second session was conducted by **Dr. Nandkumar Dahibhate**, Retired Principal Technical Officer, CSIR-National Chemical Laboratory (NCL), Pune. His topic was “**Intellectual Property Rights**”. He discussed the history of how the idea of copyright and patent came into existence. He also highlighted the importance of filing for patents and the ethics of publishing research.

On the **ninth day**, the **first session** was conducted by **Dr. Santosh Hulgabali**, University Librarian & Director, Publication Division, Central University of Haryana, Rewari, Haryana. His topic was “**Effective Online Search Techniques for Research and Publications**”. Dr. Hulgabali discussed in detail various online search techniques to make the research process easy. He also gave demonstrations of search engines helpful for research. The second session was conducted by **Dr. Babita Kannojiya**. Her topic was “**Ethics in Research**”. Dr. Kannojiya discussed in detail the ethics of research. Right methods of data collection, honesty in data analysis and avoiding plagiarism were the focus of her session.



The **tenth day** which was the last day was also the **valedictory** of the workshop. The chief guest for the valedictory was the **I/C Registrar of the University of Mumbai, Prof. Dr. Baliram Gaikwad**. Principal Dr. Somnath Vibhute, the IQAC Coordinator and Vice Principal of St. **Co-Coordinator: Dr. Ajit Yadav** Gonsalo Garcia College, Prof. Saritha Kurian, Campus Minister Fr. Dr. Solomon Ridrigues along with the participants attended the Valedictory programme. The Chief Guest Dr. Baliram Gaikwad addressed the participants highlighting the importance of the development of research culture in higher education. He stated that ethical research and hard work would lead to good research outcomes that would help society to develop. Principal Dr. Somnath Vibhute in his address commended the research development cell of the college for their efforts in conducting the ten-day long workshop successfully and encouraged the young students to undertake research. Prof. Saritha Kurien read the report of the workshop and Dr. Anil Sonawane the coordinator of the workshop registered the vote of thanks. Some of the participants shared their experiences of attending the workshop in the form of feedback.

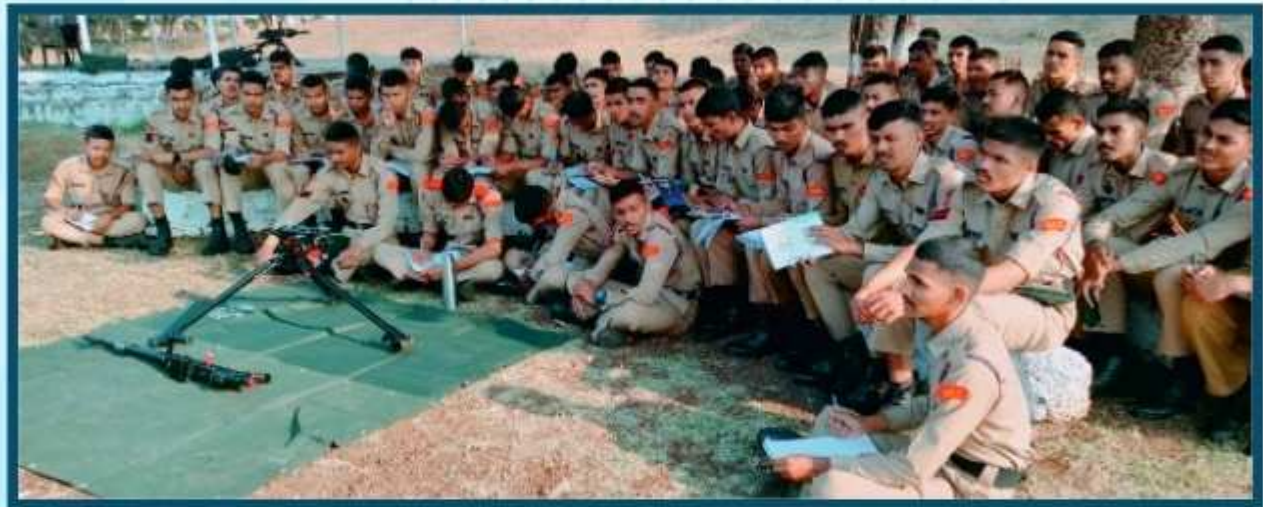
